Our Outreach

Education is also a major part of our mission as reflected in our commitment to local area students and schools. Since 1998, IRSA has annually presented Children's Concerts featuring the Brevard Symphony Orchestra for all county 5th graders. In the last 10 years, the IRSA scholarship program has awarded over \$150,000 in scholarship grants to individual students while local schools and ensembles such as Gifford Youth Orchestra, Vero Beach High School, Sebastian River Middle School, and Storm Grove Middle School have been recipients of IRSA stipends to support various orchestral and band activities. The scholarship program additionally supports aspiring musicians in middle and high school who wish to develop their skills through individual instruction. IRSA's contributions enable young musicians to discover the magic of music while mitigating cuts to arts education budgets.

Our Goals

As a non-profit arts organization, we are proud to have achieved so much for our community, yet an extensive base of financial support locally, regionally, and nationally is essential if we are to maintain our creative and organizational goals. Annual orchestra operations and contract costs are rapidly increasing, and our community outreach programs require funding each year at increasing levels. Ticket sales alone do not cover our nearly \$500,000 annual expenditures nor enable us to expand our programming in an effort to further enrich and excite others through superior classical music.
