Recognized globally for its precision, artistry, and spirit of musical collaboration, the Academy will perform a dynamic program featuring Ives's Variations on "America", Saint-Saëns' Violin Concerto No. 3 with Bell as soloist, and Schumann's Symphony No. 1, "Spring."

Bell calls the Saint-Saëns concerto "beautifully crafted, virtuosic, and a joy to play and hear." Audiences can expect an evening of brilliance and vitality from one of the world's most acclaimed ensembles.
