



Prague Philharmonia to Perform in Festival of Orchestras

Vero Beach, FL (December 20, 2025) – The Indian River Symphonic Association proudly presents the renowned Prague Philharmonia in concert on Tuesday, January 20, 2026, at 7:30 PM at the Community Church of Vero Beach.

Under the direction of esteemed conductor Emmanuel Villaume, the orchestra will offer a program rich in passion, artistry, and expressive power. Acclaimed pianist Andrew von Oeyen joins the Philharmonia to perform Mendelssohn's Piano Concerto No. 1 in G minor, a work celebrated for its dazzling virtuosity and lyrical beauty. *The Chicago Tribune* wrote, "Brilliant technique can be taken for granted among today's concert pianists, but von Oeyen's playing goes a step further. He leaves you convinced that he can do absolutely anything he likes with a keyboard."

Violinist Blake Pouliot will also appear as soloist, performing Mozart's Violin Concerto No. 3, a masterpiece of elegance and youthful spirit. *The Philadelphia Inquirer* praised Pouliot's playing for moving from "moments of great power and brawn to stratospheric notes so delicate they sounded like they could fall from the high-wire at any moment."
